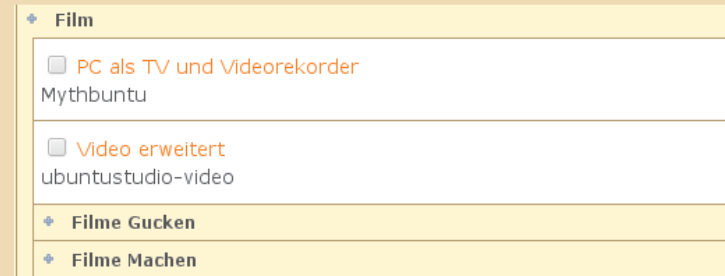

Now you have two possibilities: either you click on "Save" and you get to the page to install the software for the task you have selected or you click on "Save and choose packages" to make a detailed selection.



"Bundles" are shown to you here. These bundles consist of packages which belong to a specific task. In this example the basics for watching videos are selectet so that you can watch movies and DVDs without searching for codecs.

If you want to do more with movies you have the possibility to select more bundles, for example a bundle with which your computer is able to watch TV an record the shows.

If you want to do other task with your computer you can choose from other bundles. When clicking on a bundle name you receive links with further information, videos and reviews made by other users who want to share their experiences.

Finally, two metapackages will be created from your selections. The first one contains the sources and keys for the repositories and with the second metapackage the actual installation is carried out.

Perspective: we are currently working on the creation of CD-images based on the selections made by the user.

Communtu is available in both, English and German. Translations into other languages are expected.
